### CE-1 / CE-2 Consumer Economics

# Elementary & Middle School Classes

## SuccessMaker Computer Learning Lab

The SuccessMaker program provides individualized, self-paced online instruction for each student in reading and math. Once the student completes a series of questions, SuccessMaker places the student to the appropriate grade equivalent based on data gathered. After this initial placement, the management system tracks each student's progress and automatically provides the level of instruction appropriate to each student's needs. Additionally, it adjusts the content, skill, and strategies taught, and provides additional practice in areas in which performance is weak. Because each student proceeds at his or her own pace, it allows the student to take on greater academic challenges while building new skills, knowledge, and strategies. SuccessMaker has proven to be extremely effective in motivating students. There is a teacher available to assist students when they need help.
