Falcon Prep Day

Monday, August 21, 2017. Please enter through the **North** entrance of HHS (Falcon Gym) where stations will be set up to pay for class fees/fines, pick up class schedules and locker information, and to deposit money in lunch accounts. Pictures will be taken at this time by Dorian Photography for ASB/ID cards. **Every student must have his/her picture taken**; families wishing to purchase pictures may do so at this time.

Online Payments can be made by going to this web site: http://www.rsd.edu/parents/online-payments.html Proof of all online payments must be brought to HHS during registration.

- ✓ Fees Go to http://hanfordfalcons.org/info/student-fees-forms.html to print the form; bring this along with your payment to Falcon Prep Day. With the exception of lunch accounts, all fees may be paid in one transaction by cash, check, debit, MC or Visa (NO AM EX).
- ✓ Vehicle Registration Go to http://hanfordfalcons.org/info/student-parking.html Please refer to the attached form if you will be driving a vehicle to school. Bring completed vehicle registration form to Falcon Prep Day to receive a parking permit (no fee for permits).
- ✓ **PE Uniforms:** After purchasing your uniform, you will take your receipt to a PE teacher on freshman only day, lunch time or after school on the first day of school; or before school on the 2nd day of school. After these times, student may get uniform from their PE class.
- ✓ **Lunch** Students access their lunch account using their student ID number. Lunch prices are \$3.00 for students or \$.40 if qualified for reduced prices. Milk is \$.50. Breakfast for students is available for \$1.75 or free if qualified for reduced prices. The cafeteria cashier will be available on Freshmen Day (August 28) to deposit monies into students' lunch accounts and to answer questions.  - ❖ Your student will receive a purple release/dismissal slip to give to their teacher.
 - At the specified time, student may leave the classroom and meet you at your car.
 - You don't have to come into the building and we are able to avoid interrupting classes.
