Falcon Prep Day

Monday, August 20, 2018. Please enter through the **North** entrance of HHS (Falcon Gym) where stations will be set up to pay for class fees/fines, pick up class schedules and locker information, and to deposit money in lunch accounts. The school store will be open for students to pay for and pick up PE uniforms. Pictures will be taken at this time by Dorian Photography for ASB/ID cards. ***Every student must have his/her picture taken***; families wishing to purchase pictures may do so at this time.

Proof of all online payments must be brought to HHS during registration.

- ✓ **Fees** – Go to <http://hanfordfalcons.org/info/student-fees-forms.html> to print the form for class fees; **bring this with your payment with you to Falcon Prep Day**. All fees may be paid with one check, with the exception of P.E. Uniforms and lunch accounts.
- ✓ **PE Uniforms** – Will be available for purchase during Falcon Prep Day and Freshman Day in the Student Store. Checks should be made payable to Richland School District (RSD) for \$18 for T-shirt and shorts. This must be a separate check.
- ✓ **Vehicle Registration** – Go to <http://hanfordfalcons.org/info/student-parking.html> Please refer to the attached form if you will be driving a vehicle to school. **Bring completed vehicle registration form to registration on Falcon Prep Day for a parking permit** (no fee for permits).
- ✓ **Lunch** – Students access their lunch account using their student ID number. Lunch prices are \$3.00 for students or \$.40 if qualified for reduced prices. Milk is \$.50. Breakfast for students is available for \$1.75 or free if qualified for reduced prices. The cafeteria cashier will be available on Freshmen Day (August 25) to deposit monies into students' lunch accounts and to answer questions. - ✓ **Attendance** – Absences must be cleared by calling the attendance secretary (967-6504 or 967-6136) on the day of the absence (messages may be left after school hours) or e-mailed at: HHS.attendance@rsd.edu. Notes to excuse your student must be signed by a parent, stating the time and/or days and reasons for the absence. **Any absence NOT cleared within 48 hours will be considered a truancy and consequences will be assigned.**

- ✓ **Checking Your Student Out of School for Appointments**
 - ❖ Send a note signed by parent/guardian excusing your student at the time you wish your student to leave school.
 - ❖ Your student should bring the note to the office prior to 1st period.
 - ❖ Your student will receive a purple release/dismissal slip to give to their teacher.
 - ❖ At the specified time, student may leave the classroom and meet you at your car.
 - ❖ You don't have to come into the building and we are able to avoid interrupting classes.
- ✓ **Student Planners** – Students will receive a planner at registration; it is their responsibility to read, understand and follow the Richland School District and Hanford High School policies and procedures.
- ✓ **Bus Transportation** – Questions regarding bus transportation may be directed to the RSD Transportation Department, 967-6150 or Ben-Franklin Transit, 735-5100.
