3. Submit your message of no more than 300 characters digitally at [tinyurl.com/hanfordbabyads](http://tinyurl.com/hanfordbabyads)

Photos should be school appropriate, and even if they're cute baby shots, please don't send naked baby pictures.

Please don't paper clip or staple the photos or write on the backs. The ink can bleed onto another photo. **If you would like your photo returned, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope adequate for the return of your photo. We will return the photos after the pages and the proofs are finished – sometime during second semester.**

**Again, any pictures you send and want returned, include a stamped, self-addressed envelope.**

We have a deadline – so you have one as well. We want to include your ad, so turn it in no later than **NOV. 9 to the Bookkeeping Office.**
